Health insurance may not be purchased with HSA Funds. However, HSA funds can be used to pay for: 1) Health plan premiums during any period of continuation coverage required under any Federal (COBRA) 2) A qualified long-term care insurance contract 3) A health plan during a period in which the individual is receiving unemployment compensation under any Federal or State Law 4) For individuals over age 65, premiums for Medicare Part A or B, a Medicare HMO and/or the employee share of premiums for employer-sponsored health insurance, including premiums for employer-sponsored retiree health insurance
